





- Port Canaveral alone cannot


accommodate projected maritime demand



SPACE FLORIDA WHARF STUDY

- Space Florida completing FDOT-funded study
 - KSC, NASA, US Space Force, US Army, US Navy, Port Canaveral and LSPs
 - Identify maritime options beyond Port Canaveral
 - Federal lands and water access
 - Multiple federal agencies, land owners, users and tenants
- Final recommendations due by year end


